### Who are the people who help us?

During this topic we will try to cover as many people as possible including:

- Doctors/Nurses/Paramedics
- Postal workers/ Cleaners/ refuse collectors/ School crossing patrol.

We will start the topic by going on a 'Helping Hand Hunt' around our school to find out the various roles of the adults we meet. We will then be inviting some special visitors into school to discuss their roles with the children including a police officer, a fire fighter and an optician.

### Where do we go to get help?

We will be looking at hospitals, doctors, opticians, post offices, police stations, recycling centres, fire stations, building sites and recreating as many of these areas as we can in our Nursery 'Little Lane' town.

### How do people travel around to help?

We will be looking at the different types of transport used and conducting some experiments to find out what makes vehicles move faster.

We will be investigating the various tools and resources needed in each profession and playing games to match them to the correct person.

We will discuss how we can be helpful at home and at school and discussing how to make sure we keep safe as some jobs are for adults only!
